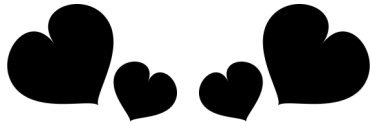
Storytime!

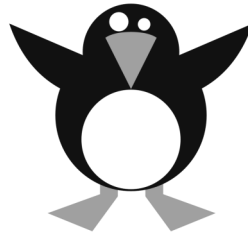


Open Play
